UNIFORM SUPPLIER

I have decided to hand the uniform back to the House of Uniforms. I will keep the current stock in school until April and after that you will need to go to The House of Uniforms. If you need new uniform and want the convenience of buying it from School, please buy before the 11th of April. We shall send you details of the shop's location under separate cover. The advantage of going directly to the shop is that if the standard sizes don't fit, they will make them specially for you and also they are able to keep a far greater stock. In addition they stock school shoes, socks and tights as well as hats and bags.

SUMMER UNIFORM

With the temperatures rising daily, the children should now be in summer uniform.

- Boys - blue shorts and green and blue shirt, white or navy socks, black or navy school shoes. **NOT TROUSERS**
- Girls - school dress, white or navy socks, black or navy school shoes. **NOT TIGHTS**

School pullover for boys and school cardigan for girls may be worn for cooler days or if they feel cold when the air conditioning is on.

MOBILE PHONES

It has been brought to my attention by concerned staff, that very often parents meet their children whilst on their mobile. Your children are often keen to share their day with you or just need a good hug after a long action packed day, especially the little ones. A parent busy on their mobile is a bit of disappointment to the child.

GATES

Once again I need to remind people how important it is for the safety of our children, that all gates are kept closed, particularly the main gate. I realise that sometimes you feel that somebody is close behind you and will close it, but we cannot afford to leave it open even for few seconds. Please ensure drivers and nannies are aware of this.

LATE ARRIVALS

If you are late for the start of school, please ensure that an adult knows your child has arrived. Do not just leave them in the hope that they will end up in their class!
